



## Lennox to Increase Growth With New Manufacturing Facility

DALLAS, Jan. 31 /PRNewswire/ -- Lennox International Inc. (NYSE: LII) announced today it will open a new production facility to keep pace with growth in the North American residential heating and cooling market and increase its manufacturing flexibility and capacity.

The new operation will be a 300,000-square-foot state-of-the-art facility in Orangeburg, South Carolina. It is scheduled for completion by the end of the year. Residential heating and air conditioning products will be manufactured at the new site to meet increasing demand for the company's North American residential products, which has seen recent double-digit growth. The new facility will initially employ about 150 people and produce gas furnaces, air conditioners, and heat pumps.

"This is a very exciting development for Lennox," said John Norris, Lennox chairman and CEO. "Our companies currently have a strong operations presence in the Midwest. With this new facility, we will leverage additional manufacturing capabilities closer to the large Southern markets where we are projecting significant future growth."

Norris said the new facility will be established based on "Lean Enterprise" principles, focusing on satisfying customer needs by eliminating waste through continuous improvement processes. Leading the initiatives for the new facility will be Mike Schwartz, President and COO of Armstrong Air Conditioning Inc. and Excel Comfort Systems Inc.
